

# HALF-ORC PHYSICAL TRAIT TABLES



o you want to play a Half-Orc? Well with a shared parentage there are a lot of possibilities of traits your character may have inherited from their parents or grandparents. Some of the prominent traits of Orcs have a chance of being lost, and others, like their strong tusks, die a lot harder.

Half-Orc appearances can be beautifully diverse with the potential shared heritage of other races of Faerun.

## HOW TO USE

Find your Half-Orcs other shared heritage on the table below. Roll a d10 on each orc trait. Rolling the number shown or higher means the orcish trait was more dominant and you should roll on the corresponding table below. If you roll less than the number listed, the non-orc parentage provided the more dominant trait, choose a common trait from that race. If no number is presented, that trait is present automatically.

### d8 Tusks

- 1 Large curling tusks
- 2 Small pointed tusks
- 3 Large Primary and small secondary tusks
- 4 Medium tusks, one broken
- 5 Opposite, curling out and downward
- 6 Sharp, aggressively curling hooks
- 7 Straight, pointing out
- 8 Absurdly large and jagged

### d8 Facial Features

- 1 Rough pock-marked skin
- 2 Wide short nose
- 3 Pronounced underbite
- 4 Bone protrusions on eyebrows
- 5 All pointed teeth
- 6 Heavy forehead
- 7 Wide heavy jaw
- 8 Small deep set eyes

### d4 Hair Color

- 1 Black hair
- 2 Dark red hair
- 3 Dark green hair
- 4 Dark grey hair

### d8 Eyes

- 1 Bright yellow
- 2 Bright green
- 3 Bright grey
- 4 Dark grey
- 5 Dark green
- 6 Dark brown
- 7 Missing one eye (roll d6 again)
- 8 Heterochromia (roll two d6, take both)

### d6 Skin Color

- 1 Green-ish
- 2 Grey-ish
- 3 Black-ish
- 4 Blue-ish
- 5 Light-speckled (roll d4 again)
- 6 Marbled (roll one d4, choose another from parentage)

### d4 Pointed Ears

- 1 Missing portion of ear
- 2 Missing one entire ear
- 3 Big earlobes
- 4 Small ears
